Cindy motioned to approve the minutes from the last meeting, Amy seconded. Motioned passed.

Paul brought up that there have been gaps in supervision before practice and that there should be no gaps. The club should assist with the supervision. Cindy thinks this needs to be addressed by the Coaches and Crystal. The club could help pay for supervision.

Carey brought up Summit Park for lacrosse but it is not ready yet. Crystal needs to be asked where spring lacrosse will practice. A conversation with Crystal about Summit Park would be helpful so that we could possibly host Fall Ball and Tournaments next year.
